





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
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





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Conclusion

PROMs

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- The voice of the patient is important when evaluating outcomes with superficial venous disease treatment as the "technical" results of all technologies are similar
- Proper PROM development includes patient interviews focusing on items relevant to patients
- The initial reliability and validity of the VenousTSQe and VenousTSQs for the first 100 English-speaking US participants of the VenaSeal Spectrum Program has been established
- While the VenaSeal Spectrum Program reports on standard outcomes (e.g. anatomic closure, return to usual activities, etc.), this research highlights patient-centric evidence.
- Further studies with superficial venous disease treatment should incorporate similar meaningful outcome measures

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
